DELIVERY OF EXHIBITS

Exhibits must be delivered to the Home Industry Hub at Clem Thompson Pavilion during these times...

- All entries, apart from consumables (food), must be delivered to the Home Industry Hub on Tuesday 3 and Wednesday 4 August between 4pm and 6pm.
- All food entries must be delivered to the Home Industry Hub on Friday 6 August between 7am and 3pm (any late entries will not be accepted due to closure for judging.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY


- Quilts must not exceed 2m x 2m in size due to space restrictions.

- Combinations of one or both sewing techniques can be used, ie. hand and/or machine sewn.
