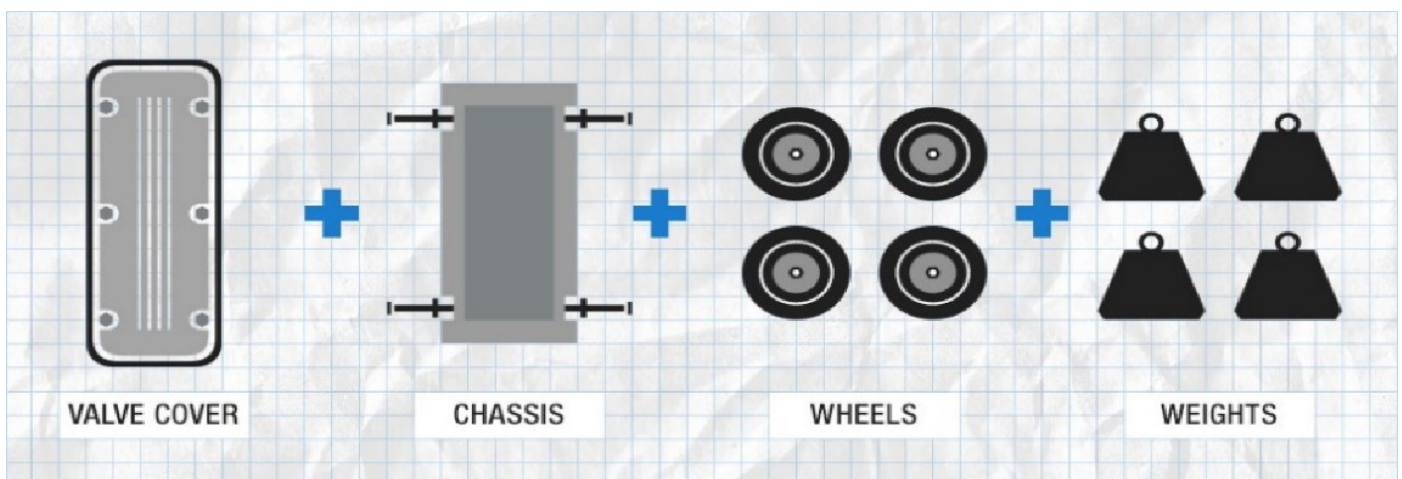

2021 Rocker Cover Racing Rules

- Cars shall be based on an actual rocker cover (valve cover) from a car engine. There shall be no limitation on engine make, model, cylinder configuration, or displacement.
- Cars must retain at least 75% of the original rocker cover, weigh no more than 4 kg and must not have any form of mechanical propulsion or steering. Gravity is your friend.
- Cars must have 3 or 4 wheels, each no greater than 15 centimetres in diameter, with the car's overall length no more than 60cm and 30cm wide.
- Racing will run in heats of 2 cars each. The first car to have its front wheels cross the finish line at least 2 out of 3 times shall be declared the winner. If neither car makes it to the finish line the closest to finish will take the win. Winning cars will advance to the next round until all are eliminated – except one champion! (The Judges' decision is final)
- Downforce wings, spoilers, air dams, etc. are all permitted. They probably won't do any good, but we will all get a good chuckle out of them.
